



Sharon's Monday Share Pee Pads

This is something many may not be aware of. I didn't know this until I learned the hard way, losing kittens when I was volunteering during the recovery efforts after Hurricane Katrina.

If you place pee pads inside a carrier housing newborn kittens or puppies and have a heating pad underneath keeping them warm, the babies can die. When the pee pads are heated, they release the chemical dioxins and phthalates, which are linked to hormonal disruptions and other health concerns.

If you need to use a pee pad when caring for kittens or puppies purchase cloth ones that can be washed and reused. Not only will the babies we safer but you will also be helping the environment.
